

# Are You a Stream Saver?



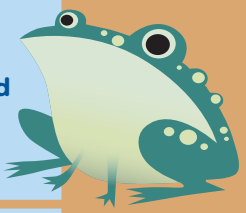
Participate in a stream cleanup.  
Move ahead 2 spaces.



Sit by the stream and relax.

Plant native plants next to stream.  
Move ahead 2 spaces.

Build parking lot that drains to stream.  
Move back 2 spaces.



Attend a community watershed meeting.

Dump paint in a storm drain.  
Move back 2 spaces.



Go fishing in stream.

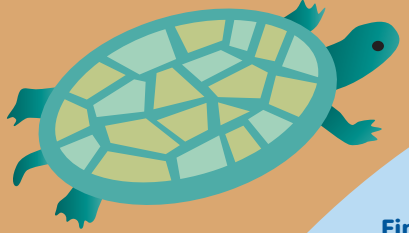
**ROLL AGAIN!**

Your company dumps wastes into stream.  
Move back 2 spaces.

Start a stream monitoring program.  
Move ahead 1 space.



Find a turtle in a stream.



Mow up to edge of stream.  
Move back 1 space.



Your neighbor has a detention pond.  
Move ahead 1 space.

A detention pond allows contaminants to settle, while water soaks into the ground or releases at a controlled rate.



Let grass clippings wash into nearby stream.  
Move back 1 space.



Tell friends not to litter.  
Move ahead 2 spaces.

Enjoy a canoe trip down the river.

Used phosphorus-free fertilizer.  
Move ahead 3 spaces.

Drive a vehicle through a stream.  
Move back 2 spaces.



Watch dragonflies at stream.



**ROLL AGAIN!**

Fence out cows from stream.  
Move ahead 2 spaces.



Go for a hike.

Calculate a biotic index.  
Move ahead 3 spaces.

Make a map of a watershed.

Wash dog in the stream.  
Move back 1 space.

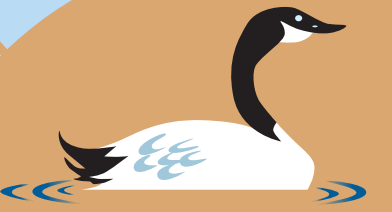
Watch geese land on stream.

Spread manure on frozen and snow-covered ground.  
Move back 2 spaces.

Tell a friend about stream monitoring.  
Move ahead 1 space.



Test water quality.

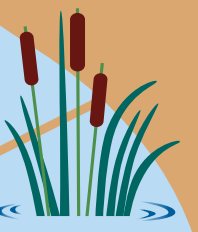


Remember, trash and other pollution that enters storm drains usually goes directly into streams and lakes.

Dump unused baitfish in stream.  
Move back 1 space.



Conduct a watershed walk.  
Move ahead 1 space.



Take photos of shoreline plants.



Look for critters in a stream.

Dam up the stream.  
Move back 1 space.



Let cows stand for hours in a stream.  
Move back 2 spaces.

Present monitoring results to your community.  
Move ahead 2 spaces.

**ROLL AGAIN!**

Find a salamander.



Allow car washing rinse to enter storm drain.  
Move back 1 space.

**GO BIRDING!**

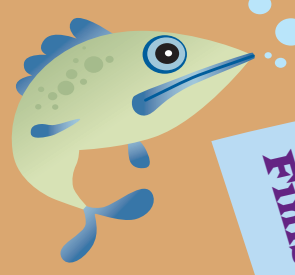


Inspect & remove weeds before launching canoe.  
Move ahead 1 space.

Collect rain water to water your garden.

Allow dirt from your construction site to enter stream.  
Move back 1 space.
